### LATEST NEWS and INFORMATION

Over the Summer we have continued to welcome volunteers to the Centre on a Monday afternoon. Their enthusiasm and hard work on the projects mean the progress we are making in photographing Finds from The Windlesham Arboretum and the Clay Pipe Collections is very satisfying.

We have had a second visit from Martin Millett as he continues in researching and writing his report on the Windlesham Arboretum: this was in order to locate Roman Pottery Finds and take a number of boxes back to Cambridge including the reference collection of the Fabric types for Roman Pottery.

We have also had a visit from the SCC Archaeological Officer for Historic Environmental Planning in July, concerning Finds we hold on the site where Jack's Fish and Chip Shop (now demolished) once stood. He spent the afternoon looking at our Finds for that site to ascertain the archaeological importance of the site.

Whilst we have continued to enjoy our archaeology at the Centre, we have, unfortunately, continued to suffer from sporadic vandalism, which is often the breaking of windows, however most recently the vandalism escalated and the garage to the side of the building was burnt down with all contents inside. The damaged garage has now been safely removed, fortunately through the insurance we have with SCC. As a result, SCC have visited us to inspect the building and its upkeep – something that is increasingly difficult to maintain.

### AGM

We were unable to hold an AGM for 2020 due to the pandemic. This year's AGM had to be delayed due to restrictions we were following, however we are hoping to hold the AGM on November 6<sup>th</sup> (Saturday), more details will follow shortly with confirmation of the date.
